

## God's I AM Statements

Gen. 15:1 I am thy shield, and thy exceeding great reward.

Gen. 15:7 I am the LORD that brought thee out of Ur of the Chaldees, to give thee this land to inherit it.

Gen. 17:1 I am the Almighty God; walk before me, and be thou perfect.

Gen. 26:24 I am the God of Abraham thy father: fear not, for I am with thee, and will bless thee, and multiply thy seed for my servant Abraham's sake.

Gen. 28:13 I am the LORD God of Abraham thy father, and the God of Isaac: the land whereon thou liest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed;

Gen. 28:15 And, behold, I am with thee, and will keep thee in all places whither thou goest, and will bring thee again into this land; for I will not leave thee, until I have done that which I have spoken....

Gen. 31:13 I am the God of Bethel, where thou anointedst the pillar, and where thou vowedst a vow unto me: now arise, get thee out from this land, and return unto the land of thy kindred.

Gen. 35:11 I am God Almighty: be fruitful and multiply....

Gen. 46:3 I am God, the God of thy father: fear not to go down into Egypt; for I will there make of thee a great nation:

Ex. 3:6 I am the God of thy father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.

Ex. 3:8 And I am come down to deliver them ....

Ex. 3:14 I AM THAT I AM: and He said, Thus shalt thou say ... I AM hath sent Me unto you.

Ex. 6:2, 8; 7:5; 14:4 I am the LORD:

Ex. 6:7 ... ye shall know that I am the LORD your God, which bringeth you out from under the burdens ....

Ex. 7:17 In this thou shalt know that I am the LORD:

Ex. 8:22 And I will sever in that day the land of Goshen, in which my people dwell, that no swarms of flies shall be there; to the end thou mayest know that I am the LORD in the midst of the earth.

10:2 And that thou mayest tell in the ears of thy son, and of thy son's son, what things I have wrought in Egypt, and my signs which I have done among them; that ye may know that I am the LORD.

Ex. 14:4 ... that the Egyptians may know that I am the LORD.

Ex. 14:18 And the Egyptians shall know that I am the LORD, ....

Ex. 15:26 ... for I am the LORD that healeth thee.

Ex. 16:12 ... and ye shall know that I am the LORD your God.

Ex. 20:2 I am the LORD thy God, which have brought thee out of ... bondage.

Ex. 27:27 ... and it shall come to pass, when he crieth unto me, that I will hear; for I am gracious.

Ex. 29:46 And they shall know that I am the LORD their God, that brought them forth out of the land of Egypt, that I may dwell among them: I am the LORD their God.

Lev. 11:44 For I am the LORD your God: ye shall therefore sanctify yourselves, and ye shall be holy; for I am holy:

Lev. 11:45 For I am the LORD that bringeth you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: ye shall therefore be holy, for I am holy.

Lev. 18:2 I am the LORD your God.

Lev. 18:5 Ye shall therefore keep my statutes, and my judgments: which if a man do, he shall live in them: I am the LORD.

Lev. 18:6, 21,30; 19:4 many more!!! I am the LORD your God. (or) I am the LORD.

Lev. 20:8 And ye shall keep my statutes, and do them: I am the LORD which sanctify you.

Lev. 20:24 ... and I will give it unto you to possess it, a land that floweth with milk and honey: I am the LORD your God, which have separated you from other people.

Lev. 22:32 Neither shall ye profane My Holy Name; but I will be hallowed among the children of Israel: I am the LORD which hallow you,

Num. 18:20 I am thy part portion and thine inheritance.

Deut. 29:6 ... that ye might know that I am the LORD your God.

Deut. 32:39 See now that I, even I, am he, and there is no god with me: I kill, and I make alive; I wound, and I heal: neither is there any that can deliver out of my hand.

Judges 6:10 I am the LORD your God; fear not the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: ....

1 Kings 20:13 Hast thou seen all this great multitude? Behold, I will deliver it into thine hand this day; and thou shalt know that I am the LORD.

1 Kings 20:28 ... therefore will I deliver all this great multitude into thine hand, and ye shall know that I am the LORD.

Psalms 50:7 I am God, even thy God.

Psalms 81:10 I am the LORD thy God, which brought thee out of the land of Egypt: open thy mouth wide, and I will fill it.

Prov. 8:14 Counsel is mine, and sound wisdom: I am understanding;

Isaiah 1:11,14 I am full of burnt offerings.... Your new moons and your appointed feasts my soul hateth: they are a trouble unto me; I am weary to bear them. (Because the people were sinful and rebellious and there was blood on their hands. See verses 4, 5, and 15. )

Isaiah 41:10 Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.

Isaiah 42:8 I am the LORD: that is my name: and my glory will I not give to another, neither my praise ....

Isaiah 43:3 For I am the LORD thy God, the Holy One of Israel, thy Saviour: ....

Isaiah 43:5 Fear not: for I am with thee: I will bring thy seed from the east, and gather thee from the west; ....

Isaiah 43:11 I, even I, am the LORD; and beside me there is no saviour.

Isaiah 43:12 I have declared, and have saved, and I have shewed, when there was no strange god among you: therefore ye are my witnesses, saith the LORD, that I am God.

Isaiah 43:13 Yea, before the day was I am he; and there is none that can deliver out of my hand: ....

Isaiah 43:15 I am the LORD, your Holy One, the creator of Israel, your King.

Isaiah 43:25 I, even I, am he that blotteth out thy transgressions for mine own sake, and will not remember thy sins.

Isaiah 44:6 Thus saith the LORD the King of Israel, and his redeemer the LORD of hosts; I am the first, and I am the last; and beside me there is no God.

Isaiah 44:24 Thus saith the LORD, thy redeemer, and he that formed thee from the womb, I am the LORD that maketh all things; that stretcheth forth the heavens alone; that spreadeth abroad the earth by myself;

Isaiah 45:5 I am the LORD, and there is none else, there is no God beside me: I girded thee, though thou hast not known me:

Isaiah 45:6 That they may know from the rising of the sun, and from the west, that there is none beside me. I am the LORD, and there is none else.

Isaiah 45:18 For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I am the LORD; and there is none else.

Isaiah 45:22 Look unto me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for I am God, and there is none else.

Isaiah 46:4 And even to your old age I am he; and even to hoar hairs will I carry you: I have made, and I will bear; even I will carry, and will deliver you.

Isaiah 46:9-10 Remember the former things of old: for I am God, and there is none else; I am God, and there is none like me, 10 Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure: ....

Isaiah 48:12 Harken unto me, O Jacob and Israel, my called; I am he; I am the first, I also am the last.

Isaiah 48:17 Thus saith the LORD, thy Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; I am the LORD thy God which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by the way that thou shouldest go.

Isaiah 49:23 and thou shalt know that I am the LORD: for they shall not be ashamed that wait for me.

Isaiah 51:12 I, even I, am he that comforteth you: who art thou, that thou shouldest be afraid of a man that shall die, ....

Isaiah 51:15 But I am the LORD thy God, that divided the sea, whose waves roared: The LORD of hosts is his name.

Isaiah 52:6 Therefore my people shall know my name: therefore they shall know in that day that I am he that doth speak: behold, it is I.

Isaiah 58:9 Then shalt thou call, and the LORD shall answer; thou shalt cry, and He shall say, Here I am.

Isaiah 65:1 I am sought of them that asked not for me; I am found of them that sought me not: ....

Jer. 1:8 Be not afraid of their faces: for I am with thee to deliver thee, saith the LORD.

Jer. 3:12 Return, thou backsliding Israel, saith the LORD; and I will not cause mine anger to fall upon you: for I am merciful, saith the LORD, and I will not keep anger for ever.

Jer. 3:14 Turn, O backsliding children, saith the LORD; for I am married unto you: ....

Jer. 9:24 (NRSV) Do not let the wise boast in their wisdom, do not let the mighty boast in their might, do not let the wealthy boast in their wealth; but let those who boast boast in this, that they understand and know me, that I am the Lord; I act with steadfast love, justice, and righteousness in the earth, for in these things I delight, says the Lord.

Jer. 15:20 And I will make thee unto this people a fenced brasen wall: and they shall fight against thee, but they shall not prevail against thee: for I am with thee to save thee and to deliver thee, saith the LORD.

Jer. 21:13; 23:30,31,32 I am against the prophets.... the false prophets

Jer. 24:7 And I will give them an heart to know me, that I am the LORD: and they shall be my people, and I will be their God: for they shall return unto me with their whole heart.

Jer. 30:11 For I am with thee, saith the LORD, to save thee: ... but I will correct thee in measure, and will not leave thee altogether unpunished.

Jer. 31:9 They shall come with weeping, and with supplications will I lead them: I will cause them to walk by the rivers of waters in a straight way, wherein they shall not stumble: for I am a father to Israel, ....

Jer. 32:27 Behold, I am the LORD, the God of all flesh: is there any thing too hard for me?
