<b>Burnt, whole</b>	Worship a pleasing odor to YHVH Lev. 1:3-17; 22:18-20; Romans 12:1-2	From herd: bull without blemish; From flock, sheep or goats: male without blemish; For poor: doves	Sprinkle on all sides of the altar	Flay it. Wash innards. Burn all on the altar.	None. All is burnt, except the priest keeps the skin (Lev. 7:8)
<b>Peace, well-being</b> Lev. 3:1-17 Lev. 7:11-21; Lev. 7:28-34; Lev. 9:18-21	thanksgiving, worship, Lev. 22:17-30; Lev. 21:21-30; Num. 15:7-12	From herd: male or female; from flock: male or female; from goats: male or female. Offer with unleavened cakes soaked in oil (Lev. 7:12-14).	Sprinkle on all sides of the altar	Burn fat , kidneys, appendage of liver, & tail.	Priests eat breast , right thigh, and one cake. Offerer and his family eat the rest. (All who eat it must be cleansed. Lev. 7:19-21.) Shoulder, jaws, stomach (Lev. 18:3)!!
<b>Sin offering</b> Whatever touches its flesh shall be holy (Lev. 6:27).	unintentional sin Lev. 4:1- 5:13; Lev. 6:24-30	Priest or whole congregation:bull; ruler: male goat; common person: female goat; poor: doves; very poor: choice flour with no oil or frankincense	Sprinkle 7 times in front of curtain if for priest or congregation. Put some on horns of altar (of incense for priest or congregation), the rest pour out at base of altar.	Fat & innards on altar. If for priest or whole congregation burn the rest outside the camp in a clean place.	If for priest or whole congregation: burn it outside camp. If for ruler or common person: the priest who offers it eats the rest in the Temple court. (Also males among the priests may eat of it. 6:29.)

**GRAIN OFFERING, Lev 2; 6:17-23 [Anything that touches them shall become holy, 6:18.]**

<b>Unleavened flour on a griddle</b>	Worship	choice flour mixed with oil, unleavened. No leaven or honey (v. 11).	Break it in pieces and pour oil on it. (For priest: well- soaked in oil. Lev. 6:21.) Offer with salt	token portion	Priest who offers it (Lev. 7:9) If a priest's offering, it must all be burnt (Lev 6:19-23).
<b>Prepared in a pan</b>	Worship	Choice flour in oil. No leaven or honey (v. 11).	With salt.	token portion	Priest who offers it (Lev. 7:9)
<b>Firstfruit offering</b>	Worship and tithe Lev. 2:14-16	Coarse new grain from fresh ears, parched with fire.	Add oil and lay frankincense on it.	token portion of grain and oil with all its frankincense	Priests and Levites (Lev. 18:4)
